- The  below/above the notes is called a slur. This tells us to only use our air to change from note to note.
- "Lip Slurs" teaches brass players how to change notes by only using our air AND without changing the valve combination/position we are in.
- The "0" tells us that we are only playing notes in open/first position
- Don't feel the need to play these all in a row, only work on them 2 measures at a time.
- Listen for a smooth change between the notes.
